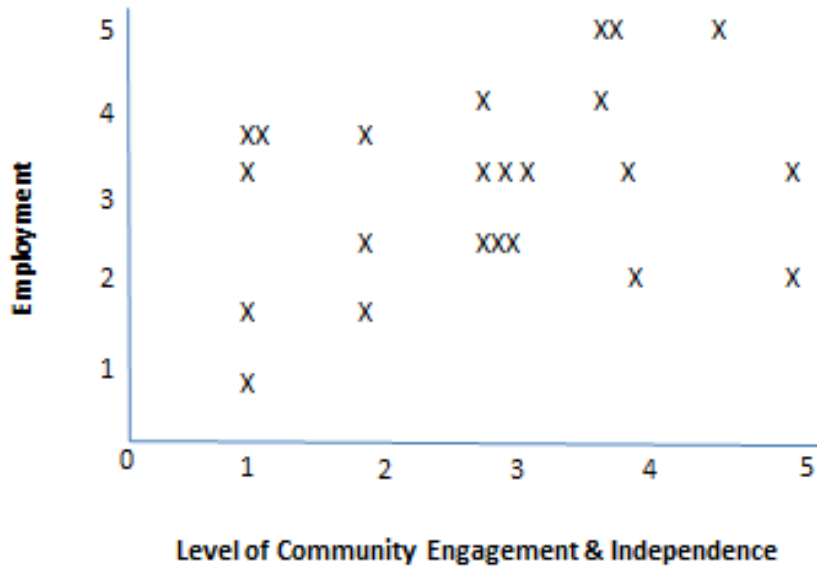


Keeping People Moving Forward

WHAT IS THIS?

WorkLink uses this scatter plot graph to visually represent the progress of individuals enrolled in our program. The points are not to show a correlation between employment and community engagement but to plot measures of success in one graph for the people we serve.

WHY DO THIS?

An Assessment of an individual's "levels of independence" is done prior to the annual planning meeting so it can be used to develop meaningful goals. Each year the individual can plot his/her progress on their personal graph. A Scatter plot is also done for the entire group (see above) and is used to determine if our services are effective.

WorkLink has found this visual representation of progress to be very motivating for the people and for program staff. The tool we are using to determine level of community engagement and independence is a very informative assessment that can be used to develop more meaningful goals and better service plans.
