- Diverse communities and workplaces

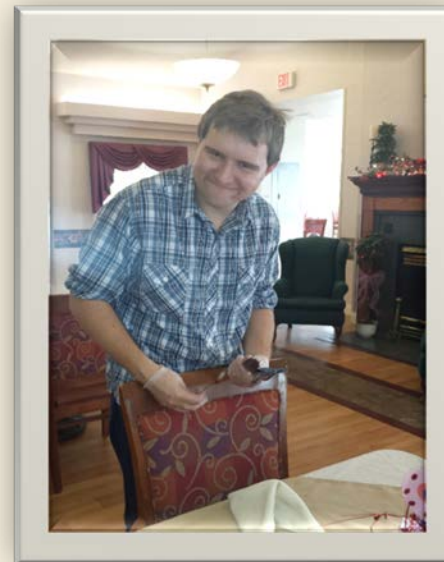
